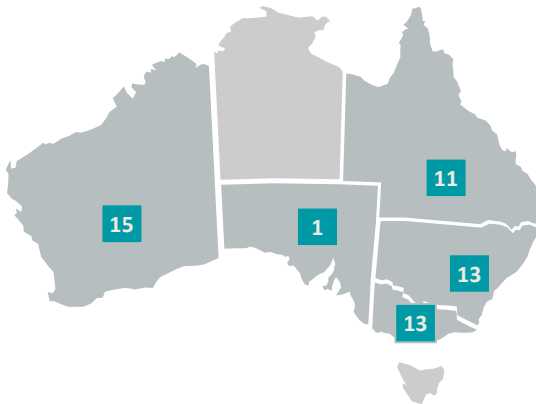
Healthscope – what we're about

Hospital services

- ⦿ ED and co-located GP clinic, plus state-of-the-art intensive care & inpatient units
- ⦿ 14 operating theatres, 2 cardiac catheter laboratories & 4 procedure rooms
- ⦿ Inpatient mental health facility
- ⦿ Full range of health services:
 - Acute Medicine, Acute Surgery, Allied Health, Ambulatory Care, Anaesthetics, Coronary Care, Emergency Medicine, Geriatric Medicine, Intensive Care, Medical Imaging, Mental Health, Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Oncology, Paediatrics, Pathology, Pharmacy & Renal Dialysis
- ⦿ GP clinic to help reduce the need for ED treatment
- ⦿ Opportunities to help people better navigate the health system
- ⦿ Specialist consulting suites within the hospital
- ⦿ Outpatient clinics

The facility

- ⦿ Healthscope to design, build & operate the hospital, in partnership with the NSW Government
- ⦿ Fully licensed private hospital, opening in late 2018 for both public & private patients
- ⦿ 488 inpatient beds
- ⦿ 9-storeys high, with room for future expansion on site
- ⦿ 1,400 car parking spaces (with rates set by NSW Health)
- ⦿ Helipad for emergency patient transport
- ⦿ Convenient café, retail & customer services, green spaces
- ⦿ First *Four Star Green Star* hospital in NSW

Teaching, training, education & research

- ⦿ Dedicated teaching, training, education & research (TTER) area within the hospital
- ⦿ Enhanced by the digital environment & integrated theatres
- ⦿ Comprehensive training & education programs for staff
- ⦿ Interns, RMOs & registrars will benefit from training programs that offer high standards of training, education, supervision, assessment, evaluation, support & safety
- ⦿ Nursing & allied health clinical placements
- ⦿ Apprenticeships

Employment

- ⦿ 1,300 positions – approx 400 more than currently at Manly & Mona Vale Hospitals
- ⦿ Permanent full-time & part-time staff, including Staff Specialists, can choose to transfer to equivalent roles in the hospital
- ⦿ JMOs will remain employed by NSW Health & rotate through the hospital
- ⦿ We will work with VMOs for appointments to the hospital
- ⦿ GP shared care model for birthing services
- ⦿ We will ensure all services are provided to the highest quality standards by competent & expert clinicians

Key milestones

- ⦿ **July 2015** – construction began
- ⦿ **2016/17** – staff Expression of Interest process begins
- ⦿ **2017/18** - recruitment begins
- ⦿ **Mid 2018** – build complete
- ⦿ **Late 2018** – patients transfer from existing hospitals
- ⦿ **Late 2018** - **hospital opens** (with all services operational)
