Hospital Discharge Pilot Project: Stay at Home

The Hospital Discharge Pilot Project: Stay at Home is accepting referrals for people with a diagnosis of dementia, or suspected dementia, who are being discharged from hospital and who are at risk of re-admission.

Participants will receive assistance through case management to link into services to support them to live as independently as possible in their own homes.

There will also be a limited amount of practical in-home support available during the first week at home.

The Project will run from 1st July 2016 to 30th June 2017.

Eligibility

- Have suspected or diagnosed dementia
- No active community care services at time of discharge
- Would significantly benefit from short-term follow up support
- Are not currently enrolled in TACP/TRANSPAC

The Stay at Home Consultants will contact all potential participants before making the final decision about accepting an individual to the program.
